Connect with God Together

We can serve others through our physical actions but we can also serve them by putting them first in our times of prayer.

Travel around your home together or scroll through recent photos on a phone, when you find a picture of a friend or family member pause and pray for them.

Why not ask God to give you an encouraging message or word which you can share with them, or to give you an idea of how you could serve them practically this week.

Memory Verse

Matthew 6 v 10

May your kingdom come and what you want be done, here on earth as it is in heaven.

Family Fun Together

Simon Says: Play a game of Simon Says together and take it in turns to be the leader, giving instructions that everybody else should follow – but only if the instruction begins with "Simon says..." You could talk about how serving others can mean putting their wants and needs first.

Serving a meal: We can serve others by helping to meet their needs. Why not bake some cakes, biscuits or a special meal and share it with somebody else this week like a close friend or neighbour.

Acts of Service Challenge

Why not challenge yourself as a family to complete as many different acts of service and kindness to others as you can this week. You could make a simple chart and keep a record of who manages to complete the most acts this week.
