A passage to unpack Ephesians 3 v 14-21

Find the book of Ephesians in the New Testament, find Chapter 3, and read verses 14-21.

Verse 21 talks about how God can work through us and use us to do amazing things for Him. Spend some time listening to God and asking how He would like to use you this week.
