A question for adults to ask children

A question for children to ask adults

What is your favourite way to connect with and draw close to God?

Connect with God Together

Spend some time waiting on God drawing close to Him together. You might find it helpful to create a cosy space to sit in and to put on some gentle music. Pray and invite God to be with you asking for a sense of His presence.

What might God want to say to you during this time?

Share with each other afterwards how it felt and any messages you may have heard from God. Remember that God can speak to us through words, pictures and feelings.

Memory Verse

Matthew 6 v 10

May your kingdom come and what you want be done, here on earth as it is in heaven.

Family Fun Together

Come to me: Jesus encouraged the children to come to him rather than be held back. Play a fun 'come to me' challenge.

The caller stands on one side of the room, the walker on the other with their eyes closed or wearing a blindfold.

The caller should encourage them to 'come to me' and guide them across the room using only their voice. Make it more difficult by setting up an assault course!

Share the love Challenge

We all have a part to play in sharing God's love with others in the world. Why not choose somebody that you would like to share God's love with this week.

Spend some time praying for them and asking God for boldness and wisdom. Then make time this week to tell them about God's love for them and the Good News about Jesus.
