Ecclesiastes 3 v 6

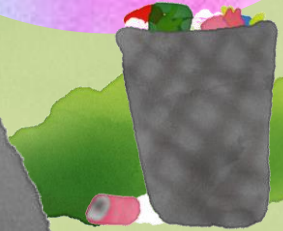
What have you learned about God this year?
