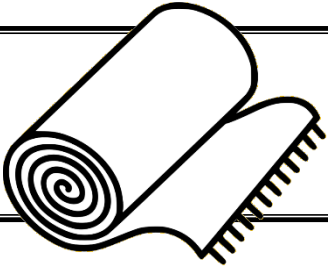

What makes a good friend?

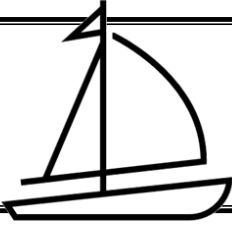


Jesus heals and forgives

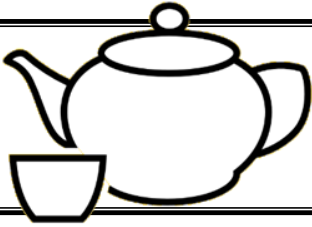

Who are some of the people who help you learn more about Jesus?

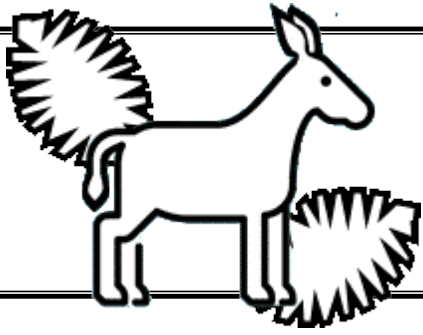

Jesus comes to Jerusalem as King

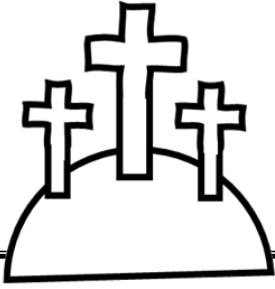
Jesus arrived in Jerusalem riding on a donkey, everybody was very excited, they waved leaves and shouted. Draw your own perfect party here.
